A LEGENDARY ROADHOUSE IN THE STAGECOACH DAYS, HOSTING MANY
OF HISTORY'S GREATS AND EVENTUALLY SHARING THE SITE OF
WILLIAM BERKELE'S THRIVING DISTILLERY IN 1868.

OUR BOURBON RESURRECTS THE LEGACY OF THE TAVERN WITH
THE HELP OF OUR MASTER DISTILLER, CHIP TATE. TWICE-KISSED BY FIRE
THROUGH A DOUBLE-BARRELING PROCESS IN SLOW TOASTED OAK
FOR A RICHER CHARACTER WITH NOTES OF CARAMEL, VANILLA
AND A WHISPER OF SMOKE.
